

# Mackenzie Gas Project



## Employment Opportunities

**The proposed Mackenzie Gas Project is committed to supporting northern employment by identifying opportunities early, and by working with local community and government resources to recruit qualified aboriginal and nonaboriginal northern employees. In some cases, a mixture of experience and education might be adequate qualifications.**

The proposed Mackenzie Gas Project is expected to create thousands of short-term jobs over three winter sessions during the peak construction period. About 45 to 55 long-term employee jobs are forecast for pipeline and related facilities operations. In addition, there may be from 35 to 45 contractor jobs associated with the overall Project operations activity.

### **JOB CATEGORIES**

#### **Entry-level Jobs**

Entry-level jobs require little or no related experience. On-the-job training is provided. Applicants may be required to read and write English and in some cases, may need Grade 12 education or the equivalent.

#### **Skilled/Trade Jobs**

Applicants for skilled jobs are typically required to read and write English and to have a Grade 12 education or equivalent. Trades positions require a trade certification or enrollment in an approved apprenticeship program. Previous work-related experience is an asset. Experienced equipment operators, such as truck drivers and heavy equipment operators, are also considered skilled positions.

### **Professional/Technical Jobs**

Applicants for professional positions have a technical school diploma or university degree. For example, a professional may have a university degree in engineering, science, commerce or business administration, or occupational health and safety. Applicants for technical positions are usually graduates of technical schools with diplomas in mechanical, instrumentation, chemical, electrical, petroleum or other technologies.
