Project Manager

Job Description	Responsible for all aspects of a project. Works in conjunction with the supervisors of a project. Maintains communication with the client(s).
Education/Certification	Although no minimum education is required, most employers prefer to hire applicants who have a bachelor's degree or college or technical diploma and extensive work-related experience.
Experience	Previous experience in managing projects.
Skills	Must be able to work quickly and think ahead to the next procedure. Needs mechanical knowledge and good organizational skills.
Salary Range	\$39,000 to \$47,000. Experienced project managers may earn \$75,000 per year or more.
Transferability	Depending on experience and discipline, project managers are found in many industries, such as mining, forestry, hydro.

Other Management Positions
**Operations
Manager**

Overall manager of all pipeline operations; responsible for the safe, smooth and efficient operation of the entire pipeline system. Appropriate technical degree and related experience required. Salary: \$80,000 - \$150,000 per year.

**Engineering
Manager**

Plans, coordinates, directs and designs production activities. Supervises engineers, technicians and support personnel. Engineering degree and related experience required. Salary: \$75,000 - \$90,000 per year or more.

**Information
Manager**

Manages the gathering and storage of information according to project standards. Requires a degree or diploma in computing and information systems and previous experience. Salary: \$35,000 - \$75,000 per year.

Note: These job descriptions represent positions frequently found in large pipeline projects. Appropriate education and experience will play a determining role when selecting candidates. Some positions may require extensive natural gas related expertise. Salaries and wages are based on 2001 data and may change according to market conditions.
