Re: Application for Land Use Permit on Inuvialuit Private Land

Imperial Oil Resources Ventures Limited (Imperial), on behalf of ConocoPhillips Canada (North) Limited, Shell Canada Limited and ExxonMobil Canada Properties, encloses ten copies of an application for a Land Use Permit. This application is made pursuant to the Inuvialuit Land Management System and the Inuvialuit Final Agreement.

This permit would allow certain activities associated with the Mackenzie Gas project located on Inuvialuit Private Land. It relates only to activities on Inuvialuit Private Land associated with the gathering pipeline for the Mackenzie Gas Project.

The purpose of the Mackenzie Gas Project is to develop three onshore anchor fields (the anchor fields Taglu, Niglintgak and Parsons Lake) in the Mackenzie Delta and to transport natural gas and natural gas liquids by pipeline to market. Within the Inuvialuit Settlement Region (ISR), the Mackenzie Gas Project will include the construction and operation of the following on Inuvialuit Private Land:

- construct and operate an infrastructure site at Swimming Point including camp, stockpile, fuel storage, and barge landing along with other access roads, travel lanes and temporary workspace along the gathering pipeline right of way
- develop seven borrow sites
- develop 23.6 km of gathering pipeline in a 40 m wide right of way
- construct block valves in the gathering pipeline right of way as required for pipeline operations

Additional activities associated with the Mackenzie Gas Project on Crown Land within the ISR, not covered by this application, include:

- develop and operate onshore gas fields at Niglintgak, Taglu and Parsons Lake
- develop and operate a pigging facility and temporary infrastructure at Storm Hills
- develop new gathering pipelines connecting the Niglintgak, Taglu and Parsons Lake anchor fields
- develop borrow sites and infrastructure to support the construction activities

Imperial is also submitting the following applications relating to the Mackenzie Gas Project within the Inuvialuit Settlement Region.

- Class A Land Use Permit application to Indian and Northern Affairs Canada for activities to be conducted on Crown Land within the ISR.
- Canadian Wildlife Service Permit, Bird Sanctuary Permit - Multi-Year Application to Environmental Canada for activities to be conducted within the Kendall Island Bird Sanctuary.
- Type A Water Licence application to the Northwest Territories Water Board for withdrawal of water, use of water and discharge of treated water in the ISR.
- Type B Water Licence application to the Northwest Territories Water Board for watercourse crossings and a barge landing site within the ISR.
- Fisheries Act Authorization to Fisheries and Oceans Canada for watercourse crossings within the ISR.

In separate applications, the operators of the Niglintgak, Taglu and Parsons Lake anchor fields will file applications with the Inuvialuit Land Administration and other regulators to address shared use of access roads and borrow sites to be located on Inuvialuit Private Land and on Crown Land.

In support of this application, Imperial intends to file with the Inuvialuit Land Administration certain additional information. This additional information will be filed either prior to conclusion of the regulatory process, or in fulfillment of conditions to approvals following completion of the regulatory process. Additional filings include information such as:

- summaries of access agreements, where required
- results of detailed environmental and engineering studies, where required
- results of Traditional Knowledge studies currently underway
- details of environmental management plans
- Land Use fees

A cheque for \$7,597.00 is enclosed which represents the application fee.
